TelePacific Communications announced on May 5, 2006 that it has signed a definitive merger agreement to acquire MPower for approximately \$204 million. The transaction is expected to close in the third quarter of 2006.

TelePacific, founded in 1998, is a facilities-based CLEC operating in Las Vegas and selected markets in California. They offer local, long-distance, data and Internet services to small-to-medium sized businesses.

MPower, founded in 1996, is also a facilities-based CLEC operating in Las Vegas, Chicago and throughout California. MPower offers data, telephony, Internet access and Web-hosting services for residential, business and wholesale customers.

Dick Jalkut, president and CEO of TelePacific who will lead the combined companies, believes that the combined businesses will gain significant synergies and efficiencies. "A deeper and denser network will allow TelePacific to deliver more products and better service to present and future customers in its markets."
