INDUSTRY UPDATE . . .

G2 announces the addition of wireless Solutions.

Service is available from Sprint & Verizon as CDMA providers and, Cingular & T Mobil as GSM providers.

EV-DO (Evolution Data Optimized) Rev. A is being deployed in the U.S. by Sprint and Verizon Wireless. Rev. A offers fast packet establishment that reduces latency and improves data rates. The downlink rate has increased to 3.1 Mb/s and the Uplink rate has a 12X improvement to 1.8 Mb/s.

Sprint currently has the broadest EVDO range currently covering over 158 million. Verizon currently reaches 150 million with EVDO. Verizon Wireless has EV-DO rolled out to 181 cities and Sprint has EV-DO rolled out to 220 cities. Sprint and Verizon now have EVDO roaming agreements giving customers of both companies free access to each others networks.

Activation, Billing & Service is provided directly by the carrier. Sprint has the leading edge for the following reasons:

- ❖ Sprint has the nation's largest Mobil broadband network
- ❖ Sprint Mobil is 5X faster than Cingular's EDGE network
- ❖ Sprint Mobil covers 3X more people, 4X more cities and 5X more airports than Cingular's BroadbandConnect Network
- ❖ Sprint is the first to market Rev A compatible devices. They estimate coverage of 40 million people with Rev A, and 200 million with Rev. 0 service by end of 2006.

GSM (Global System for Mobile) is a digital mobile telephony system that is widely used in Europe and other parts of the world. Today, more than 690 mobile networks provide GSM services across 213 countries and GSM represents 82.4% of all global mobile connections. According to GSM World, there are now more than 2 billion GSM mobile phone users worldwide. Since many GSM network operators have roaming agreements with foreign operators, users can often continue to use their mobile phones when they travel to other countries.

CDMA (Code-Division Multiple Access) refers to any of several protocols used in so-called second-generation (2G) and third-generation (3G) wireless communications. CDMA is compatible with other cellular technologies; this allows for nationwide roaming. The original CDMA standard, also known as CDMA One is still common in cellular telephones in the U.S. and offers a transmission speed of only up to 14.4 Kbps in its single channel form and up to 115 Kbps in an eight-channel form. CDMA2000 and wideband CDMA deliver data many times faster.
